

PCQ BABY OR WHEELCHAIR QUILT

Skill level: Easy

Quilt requires 36 blocks and finishes at 42" square or 44" with optional borders.



Block, 7" finished
(7-1/2" unfinished)



Straight Set Layout, no border
42" square



Straight Set Layout, with optional left and top border, 44" square

Cutting:

For blocks, from each of six different colorful prints, cut a 6" Width of Fabric (WOF) strip.

- Sub cut 6" squares, total 36 squares.

For blocks, from contrasting fabric, cut 12 WOF strips, 2" wide.

- Sub cut 36 pieces at 7-1/2" long.

- Sub cut 36 pieces at 6" long.

For optional border, cut two 2" WOF strips of your contrasting fabric.

Assembly:

Sew a contrasting 6" strip to the right side of each square.

Sew a contrasting 7-1/2" strip across the bottom of each square.

Lay out blocks in six rows of six with the contrasting fabric all going in the same direction. (or other layout of your choice)

Sew blocks into rows, then sew rows together.

If desired, sew optional border to the top and the left sides to finish framing the quilt.
