To help you create these quilts we have suggested patterns posted on the PCQ web site under the Community Service tab, then go to Patterns and Forms. The patterns can be adjusted to many of the quilt sizes needed by the charity. Select whatever pattern you like.

Please attempt to make the quilts the sizes listed below

Southwest Family Advocacy Serving boys and girls, ages 8 to 9 up to 15

CHILDREN

45" X 50"

Suggested pattern: Zig Zag uses 6" blocks + borders (6b wide x 7b high) resulting in a 46" X 52" quilt

TEENS

50" X 60" or up to 60" X 80"

Suggested patterns: 4 Patch Variation 8 ½" blocks (6b wide x 8b high) resulting in a 48" X 60" quilt

Stacked Slabs uses 4 ½" X 20 ½" & 10 ½" resulting in 50" X 64" or 60" X 80" quilt

Hospice of the Valley

42" X 42" LAP THROWS

Suggested pattern: Zig Zag uses 6" squares [no border] (7wide x 7 high) resulting in a 42" X 42" quilt

64" x 80" TWIN SIZE

Suggested pattern: Stacked Slabs uses 4 ½" X 20 ½" & 10 ½" blocks resulting in a 60" X 80" quilt

Zig Zag has 6" squares (9b wide x 12b high + borders) resulting in a 64" X 82" quilt

4 Patch Variation 8 ½" blocks (6b wide x 8b high) resulting in a 60" X 76" quilt including sashing

Hospice of the Valley - Wheel Chair Quilts

40" x 45"

Suggested pattern: Baby or Wheelchair quilt uses 7" blocks (6b wide x 7b high) resulting in a 42" x 49" quilt

Ryan House Of Hospice of the Valley

64" x 80" up to 68" x 92" (Twins)

Medically fragile children need 24/7 care

Suggested pattern: 4 patch Variation – (6b wide x 8b high) = 60" X 76" or (7b wide x 10b long) = 68" X 92" with borders per directions on the web site

Zig Zag – 6" squares (9b wide x 12b high + borders) resulting in a 64" X 82" quilt

Stacked Slabs - uses 4 ½" X 20 ½" & 10 ½" resulting in a 60" X 80" quilt
