Magdalene House

We present quilts as a housewarming gift to women who are just released from the Perryville Prison and are new to Magdalene House. The house provides safe, long-term recovery housing that allows post-incarcerated women to heal, gain employment, and save for the future. It is an arm of the Bridges Reentry Organization. There are two houses with six beds in each house, one in Avondale and one in Goodyear.

New Life Center

New Life Center is Arizona's largest domestic violence and sexual assault refuge, serving more than 1000 children and adults each year. They provide temporary housing for victims. They are women, men, teens, and children. At one time, the only facility to accept teen boys with their mothers.

Southwest Family Advocacy Center

Southwest Family Advocacy Center is a multidisciplinary facility developed and funded by the police departments of Avondale, Buckeye, Goodyear, and Maricopa County Sheriff's Office with their own funding. It is a child and family focused facility where professionals in law enforcement, child protection, prosecution, mental health, medical and victim advocacy all work together during the investigation, treatment, management and prosecution of child abuse, sexual assault, and domestic violence cases. They refer to these children as "clients" instead of "victims". Currently they are 3 to 17 years of age.

PebbleCreek Pet Companion's Club

We provide dog beds to the PebbleCreek Pet Companions Club who use them in our own community as well as provide them to various local shelters.
