

Labels for Community Service Quilts  
Effective May 2026

The process for adhering quilt labels to the back of the quilt is now a little different. NO MORE STITCHING.

It has been prepared with Steam-A-Seam 2 Lite so it can be applied with an iron. (Labels will be provided with instructions in the green baggy found on the door in cabinet 104S).

Adhere the label to the back of the quilt **before quilting the quilt on the longarm.**

If you prefer the label on the bottom left of your quilt, measure **about 12 inches in from the side and 12 inches up from the bottom** to insure that the label will not be cut off when squaring the quilt. Please remember that 4 inches has been added to all sides of the back, so make sure **not to adhere it too close to the selvages.**

**OR**

The label can be **placed anywhere** on the back of the quilt. There is no rule that says it must be on the bottom left side as you look at the back.

Peel the paper (lightly scoring the paper with a pin will help to remove the paper) from the label, position it where you desire, **Press for 30+ seconds or more (steam iron)**, it can stand the heat. Let it cool and test the edges. If loose or lifting, heat again.

Long arm the quilt and some of the stitching will also help to adhere the label.

PS If you have one of the labels that does not adhere, please use it as it is. It will take a little time for the new labels to filter out.
