One Quick and Easy Way to Make a Baby Blanket

You will need 2 pieces of fabric that go well together. Use 1/4 inch throughout.

Cut one piece so that the length of fabric is the same as width of fabric. (The width of flannel without of selvages is usually 42).

Cut 10 inch triangles from each corner.



Fold under the raw edges on each side of the blanket .



With right sides together, sew the 2 edges of each triangle together. This forms a mitered corner on each corner.



Turn right sides out. This piece forms the bottom of your blanket and has approximately has 5 inches on each side to form a "frame" for your second piece. Press so you have nice crisp edges.





Cut your second piece slightly larger than your frame opening. This is generally 27 by 27. Fit this piece inside the frame formed by the first piece. Wrong sides are together. Pin so it is nice and tight. Sew along the edges of the frame making sure to catch the second piece. You may use decorative stitches to do this.

Top stitch along the edges of the entire blanket. It is advisable to sew an X across the whole blanket to keep the pieces in place.



And...you have an easy, peasy , nice looking baby blanket.
