Appendix A - Using the Innova Bobbin Winder updated 11/29/2025

Our best practice leaves the bobbin winder threaded between users. Make sure that it is threaded correctly (refer to illustration for proper thread path on the winder).

- Place your new thread cone on the spindle, then tie on the new thread leaving a short tail. Pull thread through until you have about 18" of extra thread.
- Place the bobbin on the stem.
- Wind the thread manually 6-8 times around the bobbin, then push the "finger" down to secure.
- IMPORTANT: Pull extra thread through the cutter behind the bobbin and hold very tightly from the back.
- Press the ON button. The winder will automatically cut the thread and wind the bobbin.
 - NOTE: If you do not hold the thread correctly so that the winder cuts it, you will wind thread around the stem.
 - DO NOT leave the bobbin winder in this condition. Get the tweezers & scissors and remove the thread from the stem.
- The bobbin winder will turn off automatically when the bobbin is full.
- When complete, cut your thread. Leave the winder properly threaded.
- Check for even winding, and that the bobbin is not spongy. A well wound bobbin is your key to success.
