1. Karen opened the meeting at 9am.
2. Debbie reported 117 are registered for the Christmas luncheon. Quilters are invited to enter at 10:30. The program will start promptly at 11.

4. Darlene reported that Linda R collected \$2340 in donations for the Veterans and their guests luncheons. Bill for the luncheon was \$2110.46. Current balances in Checking is \$6381.61, Long Arm: \$11,610.78, Petty Cash \$50, Balance: \$18,042.39.

6. Linda P reported being pleased with the 4 hour long arm sessions. This allows the machine to be more fully utilized. A discussion followed about possibly increasing the hourly fee to increase the amount being put aside to purchase a new longarm in the new building. Also to compensate for increasing thread costs.

Another idea is starting a block of the month club on the third Tuesday evening of each month. Karen B offered use of her e-quilt program to design the quilt. Each month would teach a new skill.
9. Julie: Cheryl McGovern will teach a new Beginner Class starting on Saturday, Jan 14, 2-4 pm. The class will run for 8 weeks, ending on March 4th. Still working on setting up other classes. Luncheon speaker will be Kelly Grant from Cactus Quilting. She is not charging a fee, but we are providing her lunch. Donna will also prepare a small gift.
10. Donna- The Featherweight club communication is only going to the members. Sue W needs to tell Maureen when there is a change in the schedule. Dec 26 meeting is also cancelled. Donna wants to do a social activity in January – still planning one for the evening. Perhaps a Happy Hour somewhere?

11. Joellen – we are selling things in the Gallery. We need a volunteer to make the 2024 Opportunity Quilt and coordinate ticket sales for the 2023 quilt.
12. Karen read the letter received from the Women’s Giving Quilt asking for a quilt to be donated for their auction to raise \$\$ for the Aqua Fria food bank. Karen will give them a charity quilt.
13. Chris Booth, a member of the nominating committee with Terri Burnett and Joanne Stancell , asked for clarification of dates of when names are needed. February announce ballot, vote in March, install at the April luncheon, Assume duties on May 1.
