**Call to order:** 9 am Meeting called to order by Phyllis Morrow.

**Approval of January board minutes:** Motion to approve C. Schwartz, Second, K. McCarty motion passed.

**Reports of Officers:**

**Vice President:** K. McCarty reviewed the Spring Luncheon plans. She made a motion and seconded by C. McGovern to charge \$20.00 per person. Motion passed. It is a picnic theme, C. S. and K. M. will work on tablecloths and centerpieces. K. Mack will include information in the newsletter about the luncheon sign up. There is a timeline of the event that K.M. will share with the board. Andi Stanfield will be the luncheon speaker and she will offer a class in April.

The program for the March meeting of the PCQC will be three of our members who were on the quilt retreat cruise to Hawaii.

K. McCarty and C. McGovern will join the zoom class on Building Healthy Quilt Guilds on March 10, 2026. C. Schwartz made a motion and C. McGovern seconded that (K.M. and C.M.) represent the board and participate in the class. Motion passed.

**Treasurer:** C. Schwartz reported that the CD rate from Wells Fargo has been reduced to 1% and she will investigate other options before the automatic renewal occurs and the purchase of another CD for \$6000.

She is able to add a column in the records to keep track of monthly attendance at meetings. She will ask R. Jones to estimate January and February.

A donation of \$750 will be itemized in the appropriate category.

The Long Arm subsidy for bobbin cases remains open as to who qualifies to receive them. C. Schwartz will talk to the LA committee chairs and co-ordinate purchases of the bobbin cases. Their recommendation to have an end date to purchase subsidized bobbin cases has been tabled. P. Morrow will contact the committee as to this decision.

**Old Business:**

P. Morrow reported that there are 9 raffle baskets for the quilt show, with a variety of themes. Several items have been donated. She has purchased supplies needed for the quilt show. She has made arrangements for the transport of the pipe and drape and the take down and return of several items.

C. McGovern will create a "Viewer's Choice" ballot box. K. McCarty has ballots, intake forms and pick up forms and other items printed. She will print more voting ballots.

There are still openings for Membership, Publicity, and Social Committee chairs. Our board needs help from our members, please consider volunteering for a committee.

**New Business:**

C. McGovern is looking in to the possibility of teaching a **small group beginning** quilting class. The specifics are still being discussed.

P. Morrow reported that the Quilt Show over Labor Day Weekend has offered our club a free booth to sell Opportunity Quilt raffle tickets.

P. Morrow will send out a request for reports from committee chairs prior to the monthly board meeting.
