**President:** Ronda Jones called the meeting to order at 9:00 am.  
June meeting minutes are accepted as written.

**Long arm:** Roberta reported that using the buddy system doesn't mean you have to stay together as buddies. Assistant title definition and buddy definition need clarification. Ronda will add a section for certification to long arm registration form. There will no longer be assistants. Anyone just helping and not quilting, does not need to sign up.

Reminder: When making charity quilts, Backs MUST be at least 3 - 4" larger on all sides.

**New business:** The CAC Council has created a committee for the purpose of creating a footprint for the future by asking club presidents to provide what the clubs needs and concerns are for the future. Due to the growth of the community, each club is finding the need for more space. The finished report will be a proposal sent to Robson for more or larger facilities. What does our club need for the future?

Ronda received an invite from 1<sup>st</sup> Southern Baptist Church in Buckeye to come and speak on September 9. They would like us to talk about what we do and the charities we support. We will take show and tell. Lunch will be at noon then the presentation will follow.
