Monday night sewing has been going well. Tonight will be Microwave Bowls.

Robin Long, quilt designer and ruler designer who does Mariner's Compass will do a presentation at our February Meeting. February meeting has been moved to Feb 21 in Chianti Room and she will do a workshop the next day, Feb 22.

Sandy will continue to work with Julie Baird, the new program person.

Long Arm: Roberta reported the bobbins are still short because there are many partial bobbins not being finished. Bobbins can be ordered and this opportunity will be announced at the luncheon. They will be ordered on Dec 17.

Sixteen people are left on the list to be trained and certified to use the longarm. There are now more than 50 quilters using the longarm.

Clarification: Any charity quilts done on the longarm for organizations other than those we support, should be paid for as a personal quilt.

New Business:

Members that do not renew by December 31st will be given a grace period until January 31 before removing them from the roster. However, only paid members may sign up for classes. Otherwise they must pay the non-member fee.
