2. Karen Bogadi called the meeting to order at 7pm. New members and guests included: Kathy Clark, Margo Powell, Jean Crabtree, visitor, Sharon Nelson from MN, visiting, Bonnie, Barb Streisand, new member, Carol Hendrix, Dixie from CO, visiting.
3. Debbie Arsenault, VP, reminded us the spring luncheon is April 11, details to follow. Save the Date!
4. Linda Publicover, Longarm, reminded everyone who wants to be certified or recertified to contact someone on the committee directly. Pantographs and bobbins need to stay in the room. Do not take them out.
5. Barb Mauer reminded us the Quilt Show is March 20. Business cards were given to everyone – share them with friends and neighbors!
