1.) President Karen Bogadi called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM.

2.) Vice-President Debbie Arsenault reported the Spring Luncheon will be held on April 10th, please save the date. Attendance: 91

1. President Karen Bogadi opened the meeting at 7pm. She introduced the 6 new members and asked for and introduced the visitors. Reminders: If you are the last one in the room, be sure you check that the power strips are all turned off and all cabinets are locked.
2. Debbie Arsenault announced that the Spring luncheon will be April 10, 11am. Waivers no longer need to be signed annually, so they will not be passed around tonight as previously planned.
3. Julie Baird, education, announced the classes – Big Bag class this Thursday has several openings. 2/21 is Block of the month. 2/23 Needle turn is full. 2/24 is no show binding. 2/28 is Kaleidoscope class. March has Opportunity quilt class, Animal applique class. Quarter Stripes class (samples on the table). 3/21 is block of the month.
4. Mary Hill thanked the longarmers who regularly quilt the charity quilts. The larger twin size quilts also need to be done – please consider them. The leftover backing strips can be recycled. Reminder: take the empty dog beds from the cabinet. Make sure pieces are less than 4” square. Sew it closed before returning. Feb 18, from 8:30 – 1:30 is a Charity Quilt Sew day. Bring your own project or kits will be available. Emphasis on twin size quilts.
5. Chris Booth announced the nominations for new officers for next year. Longarm Machine: Roberta Penchina, Community Service: Hiromi Bashore, Education: Deb Campbell, Treasurer: Darlene Helker, Secretary: Julie Baird, Vice President: Linda Rowe, President: Debbie Arsenault. We still need a person for Publicity, which is an elected position and has voting rights.
6. Karen Mack announced she conducted an audit of the financial records. She commended Darlene for impeccable books.
7. Linda Rowe is heading the Opportunity Quilt for 2024. 76 people have signed up to make a block. 3 meetings coming up starting tomorrow. Just attend one of them. Linda Publicover will offer a class on Seam Management on March 16. See Linda if you can't make any of the meetings and she will help you get a pattern for a block.
8. Kathleen reported the Challenge Quilts are due March 1. You may place them in cabinet 104X if you need to leave your project earlier, starting 2/26. From 9:30 on March 1 they will be accepting them in the hall, to put them in the display cabinet. Put your name on the back of the left side of the quilt before turning them in.
9. Donna Aybar spoke about Monday night Madness. First Monday of the month is held jointly with the No Shame Train. Last Monday of the month is the Featherweight

Meeting. Third Monday will be a Sew together – making some spiral table toppers as shown. She held a drawing for the leftover door prizes from the luncheon. Four winners!

10. Maureen reminded that if you enter the CAC before 9am, you must enter from the outside back door – not the front door.
11. Sue Whaples made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Teri Burnett. Meeting was adjourned at 7:26pm.
