Board Meeting 1-3-2022

Attendance: Karen Bogadi, Debbie Arsenault, Roberta Penchina, Linda Publicover, Ronda Jones, Mary Hill, Jonnie Chandler, Joellen Cruze, Chris Booth, Carol Moonan, Darlene Helker

1. President, Karen Bogadi opened the meeting at 9am. She said the main item of business would be discussion and approval of the budget for 2022.
2. Darlene Helker shared the treasurer's report and distributed a draft copy. After much discussion, Debbie moved that we accept the budget and Carol seconded it. Motion carried unanimously. Darlene will send out the final version electronically that we discussed and approved.
3. Jonnie reported the Quilt Show will be set up on March 18 and 19. Show will be on Sunday, March 20, from 10 - 4. She showed copies of the banner, bookmarks and flyer that will be used. She will check that a possible sign could be used at the gates. She will first check to see if there is any restriction to do this, and then gather prices.

New Business:

4. Ronda reported there are 175 paid members currently. \$4275.00 in dues coming in. With 5 additional new members predicted, we could expect \$4400. Last year's opportunity quilt brought in \$1690. Dawn Harvey will coordinate sale of 2022 Charity Fundraising Quilt.
5. We need an equipment manager to maintain rotary blades, irons, etc, including the new Sewing Machines. Joellen will clean the Janome machines every two weeks. She will also start a sign in sheet for the machines. This will allow us to keep track of how many hours the machines are used and when they should be serviced. This change will be announced and sent out via email.

6. After a discussion of possibly changing the price to sell Charity Quilts if was determined that Baby quilts will remain \$75, larger quilts may be up to \$90.

7. Mary moved that we change the name back to Opportunity Quilt, Jonnie seconded. It was approved to keep name as the Opportunity Quilt, instead of calling it the Charity Fundraising Quilt.

8. Mary Hill presented the Community Service schedule for the year, which is attached to these minutes. She would like to have a speaker from SW Family Advocacy come and talk about how the quilts we give them are used and how much they are appreciated. The board was very much in favor of this.

9. Monday's meeting will be held in Chianti Room next week. Ronda will contact John Pugsley and Carol will contact the quilters who have completed the projects Maureen left unfinished so they may be presented to John at our January meeting.

10. Mary Hill moved and Jonnie seconded the motion to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 10:30 am.

3. **Reports:** Budget, Board and General Meeting minutes and treasurer's report are all posted on the website.

It is very rewarding to participate in the show. Ronda: spoke about the entry forms, due Feb 22, on the website. She prefers them to be completed electronically. All levels of quilts are desired, including from beginners. A photographer is needed for the show. The Gallery will be open, and the Opportunity Quilt will be available for ticket sales during the show. No admission fee will be charged.

8. **Annual Challenge:** Kathleen requests this year's Split Complementary Color Challenge quilts be turned in on March 1, from 9-12 noon. If you cannot come then, quilts can be put in cabinet 104C. The challenge quilts will also be included in viewer's choice in the Quilt Show. Put your name and colors used on the back of your quilt.

Robin Long, a National Teacher is coming to our February 21 General Meeting to present a trunk show. She will teach a class the following day. Other class details are on the website.
