Community Service –Hiromi - While you have to make the entire quilt, we will support you with fabrics and batting. We have created a “border fabric” bin. You can find large pieces of fabric to help you make borders.

If you need binding done, place the quilt in “Need Binding” bin in Cabinet 104-W.

Place fabric donations in the “In-take” box in Cabinet 104-S. Do not leave it in any other location. We only accept **cotton** fabric. A question was asked if you take material to make a quilt but still have leftovers, do you place it back where you got it or put it in the “In-take” bin? Hiromi responded to place it in the “In-take” bin.

Anything in the Adopt-A-Quilt bin will first be processed by one of the Community Service Members first.

You will find bags marked Adopt-A-Quilt with the contents holding enough fabric and colors better suited to finish the top. You will still need to find fabrics to create the backing.

In the near future you will find cabinet door markings to better help you find what you need to complete charity quilts.

We are in search of a co-chair or two for the Community Service Committee. If you are interested please let me know.

Next Saturday is CS Sew Day, please come out and join us in creating quilts for the charities.
