Pint Cozy by Karen Tembreull

Size: 4" x 4" x 4"

Weaving Level: All Levels

Materials Fee: \$79.

The basket fits a pint mason jar which I will supply. Materials are Birch Bark, Willow Bark and Cotton Cord. It's suitable for all level of weavers. The basket begins with Birch Bark Hex base that converts to bias weave on the sides. A threaded base overlay, in willow bark, adds a beautiful element to the weave and bulks up the overall feel of the basket. Cotton cord is used for twiner and rim (buttonhole stitched) sticher.

Students should bring spoke weights and micro clips (12) & tapestry needle, with your regular weaving tools.



Striped Storage With Feet

by Marlene Meyer

Size: 5-1/2" x 5-1/2" x 5"H

Weaving Level: All Levels

Materials Fee: \$49.

Starting with a footed unique base, students will use dark brown and natural spokes. Weaving with dark brown and natural for weavers to make a stripe design. The rim is leather with an overhang of leather on one side. Embellish with a whale bone or something unique I have to share, pods, bone, beads ect. — or bring something special from home you would like to embellish with.

Students should bring InstaCure glue and awl along with your regular weaving tools.



Basket Beauty by Marilyn Moore

Twined Wire Pendant

Size: 2-3/4" Diameter x 2-1/2" Height

Weaving Level: All Levels

Materials Fee: \$50.

Learn to twine and make miniature baskets on this little "Beauty". Shaping and blending colors with fine colored wires is the focus of this class. Attach your favorite beads to dangle beneath the disc and make a very beautiful and wearable pendant.

Students should bring small wire cutters, chain nose pliers, round nose pliers, small packing tool, embroidery needles sizes 1-5, nylon jaw wire straighteners and personal light.



Tea Box by Annetta Kraayeveld

Size: 4-1/2"L x 2-3/4"W x 1-3/4"

Weaving Level: Intermediate

Materials Fee: \$30.

This beautiful little basket is a perfect hostess gift and a wonderful introduction to weaving with painted paper. Woven with start stop rows woven over a form to aid shaping, then a simple woven embellishment completes the basket. Teacher will provide a wide choice of paper (painted and pre-cut). This is a beginner paper basket BUT not a beginner basket.

Students should bring sharp scissors, toothless alligator clips, small bent packer and a #22 tapestry needle.

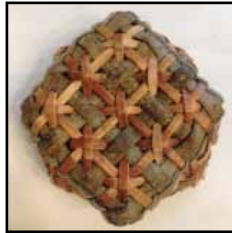

Fluted Constellation by Karen Tembreull



Size: 6"L x 6"W x 2½"H

Weaving Level: Intermediate-Advanced

Materials Fee: \$89.

Beginning with a unique threaded base of Willow and Cedar Barks; weave this sweet and functional basket with an interesting twist. The fluted sides and rim are resultant of a weave change on the basket. The braided cedar rim enhances the overall flow.

Students should bring spoke weights and micro clips along with your regular weaving tools.

Tapestry Wall Hanging by Marlene Meyer

Size: 9"L x 5"W x 9"H

Weaving Level: Intermediate

Materials Fee: \$48.

Students will use reed for the spokes to form the tapestry weave. Learn how to incorporate yarn to make designs for the tapestry weave. Finish 2 rims on the top and the bottom with lots of naturals or leather, depending on how you want your wall hanging to look. You will have a choice of lots of hanger pieces on the top, chollia, branches and antler, whatever I can find. Or incorporate something you have at home to use! Lots of fun and everyone will have there own unique wall hanging!

Students should bring InstaCure glue and awl along with your regular weaving tools.



Mini Posey Basket by Marilyn Moore

Size: 2" Diameter x 2¾"H

Weaving Level: All Levels

Materials Fee: \$55.

This sweet little basket is perfect for you to imagine gathering the first flowers of spring. Explore twining with fine wire, blending color and then making a handle, to turn this into the perfect basket in your dreams of spring.

Students should bring small wire cutters, chain nose pliers, round nose pliers, small packing tool, nylon jaw pliers, embroidery needles sizes 1-5, personal light & extension cord.



Patched Tray by Annetta Kraayeveld

Size: 12"L x 12"W x 2"H

Weaving Level: Advanced

Materials Fee: \$80.

A beautiful eye-catching basket to use or display. The colorful twill pattern in the base is continued as you weave up the side of the basket. Color choices available in class.

Students should bring a spoke weight, small packer and a #20 tapestry needle along with your regular weaving tools.

Barks on the Bias by Karen Tembreull



Size: 7½" x 6½" x 5 ½" **Weaving Level:** Intermediate **Materials Fee:** \$114

Students will learn to bias weave this non-traditional basket with thin birch bark. Overlays of Poplar and Hemlock barks will be added for color and textural notes. The faux braided rim was taught to me by master basketmaker Dawn Walden and is executed with cedar bark. A hanger handle is sewn and installed with fine brass washers to secure the stitching.

Students should bring a scratch awl, spoke weights and micro clips along with your regular weaving tools.



Half & Half Cathead by Marlene Meyer

Size: 5½"L x 5½" - base W x 6½"H

Weaving Level: Intermediate

Materials Fee: \$57.

Students will be making a cathead on a wooden base. The shaping is critical and will be watched closely. Top design is variegated reed and the rim is very unique with flat oval on the inside and yarn on the outside rim (half & half). You may embellish the yarn waterfall on one side with some naturals I will have to choose from. Pods, bones, stones, turquoise etc. Very fun and you can get creative too!



Lavaliere by Marilyn Moore

Size: 2½"W x 2½"H

Weaving Level: All Levels

Materials Fee: \$25.

Make this bead encrusted pendant exploring ways to use wire cloth and beads, this luxurious looking pendant will be a fun exploration into these materials. Hemming wire cloth and stitching beads using simple beading techniques will be covered.

Students should bring small wire cutters, chain nose pliers, metal burnisher (available for use or purchase in class), small metal ruler, cutting mat, extension cord, and personal light.



Cordella by Annetta Kraayeveld

Size: 4½" Diameter x 6" Height

Weaving Level: Intermediate

Materials Fee: \$50.

This adorable vase shaped basket features colorful cord and a well-placed button to accent multi-colored spokes. Techniques include 2/2 and 3/3 twill and twining. The challenge is controlling the shape while working with very fine material. Most students will rim after class.

Students should bring small bent packer and #22 tapestry needle along with your regular weaving tools.

PLEASE BRING your basic weaving supplies—water bucket, pencil, basket scissors, packing tool, clothes pins, knife or shaving tool, spoke weight and band aids. Any special items listed in the class description's "BRING" section. A good attitude and patience. Please put your cellphone on silent.

SKILL LEVELS

Please evaluate your skill level not only for your total weaving experience, but also for your experience in the techniques offered in the class you are considering. Beginners qualify for classes labeled all levels.

Advanced Beginner

Weavers are becoming proficient in basic weaving techniques including over/under weaving, start/stop weaving, twining, and rim lashing. They are learning to control shape. They will be introduced to new pattern weaves such as twill, different twining methods, and rim and handle finish variations. If you are taking a class in a material you have never used, you are a beginner in that class.

Intermediate

Weavers are gaining proficiency in weaving techniques. They have no trouble setting up bases, twining, over/under weaves and rims using the materials offered for a class.

Advanced

Weavers are proficient or have mastered weaving techniques. They are ready to take on more challenging projects. Teachers depend on students to have achieved this skill level to attend their class. Basic skills are not reviewed due to time constraints.
