Size: 11" Height x 4-1/2" Diameter

Weaving Level: All Materials Fee: \$45. Students will be weaving around a 33 oz. patterned glass decanter with a sealing stopper. Simple instructions will be given to weave a hexagon base, twining, and chase weave. The class is for one decanter with a choice of Tuscany red or burgundy wine inspried colors.

SPECIAL TOOLS NEEDED: Spoke weight, small clips and towel.

by Kathy Petronzio Size: 6" Diameter x 5" Height Weaving Level: All Materials Fee: \$68.

This lovely basket is woven over a ceramic Japanese bowl. There is a slotted ash base and it is woven using cane. Waxed linen is used to lash your navy blue rim.



Fall Back by Jamie VanOekel

Size: 5" W x 5-1/2" D x 3" H Weaving Level: All

Materials Fee: \$25.

Use overlays, wrapped handles and double lashing to create a fun basket perfect for giving. A second color choice (Spring Forward) will also be offered at class time.

Materials Fee: \$65.

This basket is woven using smoked and dyed reed, and natural and dyed cane. Cane overlays create a beautiful pattern around the basket. It is finished with leather handles.

SPECIAL TOOLS NEEDED: Large Towel, Spoke Weight

Large Weekender Tote

Size: 15" L x 6" W x 8-1/2" H with handle Weaving Level: Intermediate Materials Fee: \$85.

Large tote perfect for a weekend getaway. Different sizes of reed, both round and flat and flat overlays are used for interest. An overlay is woven on each side. Your outer rim is the same leather as the handle and a beaded trim is lashed on under your rim.



Take Out

<u>Size:</u> 13" L x 9" W x 5" H Weaving Level: All Materials Fee: \$60.

This is a great basket to gather all the little things you need to "take out" to the porch. Color placement with stakes and overlays takes center stage in the design and adds personality to basic weaving techniques. Shaker tape handles complete the package for extra support and easy storage. A second color choice of green and black will also be offered. **SPECIAL TOOLS NEEDED:** Large towel and spoke weight.

SKILL LEVELS

Please evaluate your skill level not only for your total weaving experience, but also for your experience in the techniques offered in the class you are considering. Beginners qualify for classes labeled all levels.

Advanced Beginner

Weavers are becoming proficient in basic weaving techniques including over/under weaving, start/stop weaving, twining, and rim lashing. They are learning to control shape. They will be introduced to new pattern weaves such as twill, different twining methods, and rim and handle finish variations. If you are taking a class in a material you have never used, you are a beginner in that class.

Intermediate

Weavers are gaining proficiency in weaving techniques. They have no trouble setting up bases, twining, over/under weaves and rims using the materials offered for a class.

Advanced

Weavers are proficient or have mastered weaving techniques. They are ready to take on more challenging projects. Teachers depend on students to have achieved this skill level to attend their class. Basic skills are not reviewed due to time. constraints.

Ice Queen

Size: 7-1/2" x 9" H Weaving Level: All

Materials Fee: \$55.

Description: This beautiful basket will be woven around a metal ice bucket which has a plastic liner, lid and scoop. You will weave on a wooden base using natural and dyed reed, with several colors to choose from. You can choose a twill pattern or weave over/ under. Teacher will provide a twill chart.



Divided Tin Tray

by Kathy Petronzio Size: 12" L x 8" W x 4" H with handles Weaving Level: All Materials Fee: \$75.

This is a simple basket that weaves up the tray using 1/4" flat oval space dyed reed. The rim is lashed using waxed linen. Great to use on your patio or deck.



Hippity Hop

by Jamie VanOekel

Size: 7-1/2" W x 5-1/2" Diameter x 7" H with handle Weaving Level: All Materials Fee: \$35.

Basic weaving techniques start and finish this basket. In between, you will use the cross Stitch technique to dress up a band of color while working on shaping a Williamsburg handle. The handle will be wrapped to give it the extra "wow" factor. A second color choice will be available at class time. SPECIAL TOOLS NEEDED: Spoke weight.
