- 4:15-5:15pm Youth All Star Auditions ( 9-13 y/o; 2012-2017 birth year)
- 5:15-6:15pm Teen/Senior Drill Auditions (13+ y/o)
- 6:15-7:15pm Senior All Star Auditions ( 13-19 y/o; 6/1/2006-2013 birth year)

\*Dancers must attend all Drill and All Star prep classes in order to audition for Dance Industry All Star. Dancers may audition up one level for drill company; there will be at least 2 dances/teams, and each dancer will be cast in at least 1 dance. All Star dancers may be cast in 1-5 dances and will be responsible for their age-appropriate team first and may dance up; ie, a 9-10 y/o is responsible for mini before youth and a 13 y/o is responsible for youth before senior.
