RECITAL COSTUME:

Please note all hairstyles will be high ponytail unless otherwise noted in your costume detail email. Your dancer's make-up will be brown and neutral shades on eyelids with black or dark brown mascara. Most importantly, all-female dancers need a rosy blush on the cheeks and true red lipstick. Cheeks and lips are key in enhancing and highlighting the facial features, smile, and expressions of your dancer to be seen from a distance. Stage lighting is very bright and can wash a dancer out without a rosy heavily applied cheek coloring. It is the responsibility of the parent to make sure their child's costume is altered to fit them appropriately. Please remember, these costumes are not custom-made and are ordered to fit each child as close as possible. We will always try to exchange costumes (if time allows) but most of the costume companies do not keep extra costumes in stock.

RECITAL TIGHTS:

All dancer's participating in Revue 2024 are required to purchase tights directly from the front office. We have sized your dancer and ordered for you. Your account will have a \$12.00 charge added and processed on **Monday, April 15th for the recital tights. Tights Pick-Up Week will be held from Monday, April 22nd - to Saturday, April 27th.** Families can stop by the front desk from 4:00-6:00pm to pick up tights. An office staff member will also be available to answer any questions you may have over this year's revue.

RECITAL PICTURES:

Recital pictures will be taken from **Monday, May 13th through Saturday, May 18th.** Pictures will be taken during each class time. We want to ensure each dancer is in the group photo and all those interested in individual photos have the opportunity to get those taken as well. We will take the group photos first and then take individual photos. If time allows, we will run each dance in costume. Please know this is meant to be a special and fun day for the kids to try on their costumes and practice getting ready for the recital. We will send out an email a week prior to review all proper protocols for picture day.

Texas Traditions is in charge of all pictures and has no connection with Dance Industry or access to our systems for payment. Recital Picture Forms are to be completed online only with a debit or credit card. Purchasers get to see all the images before placing their order. The orders are printed and shipped individually for each person – please note there will be a postage charge added. Siblings can combine into one order per family. There is a flyer at the end of this packet with more information.

We will send a separate email to you as we get closer to picture week so you can be prepared to order accordingly.



REVUE REHEARSAL AT DI:

All classes will run their routine in their weekly scheduled class the week of May 6-11, 2024, in the White Theater. Please do your best to attend classes that week.

Dancers will **NOT** need to wear a costume for this rehearsal.

DRESS REHEARSAL AT ALLEN PERFORMING ARTS CENTER:

Dress Rehearsal will be held May 20-23rd at Allen Performing Arts Center. Please find the Dress Rehearsal schedule at the end of this packet.

Each dance your dancer will be dancing in will have time to rehearse on stage in costume at Allen Performing Arts Center. It is called a dress rehearsal because the dancers wear their costumes, stage make-up, and required hairstyle just as they will be during the recital.

Attending dress rehearsal is **mandatory** for every dancer participating in the revue. If they do not attend, the dancer will not understand their placement on the stage or the process. When viewing the dress rehearsal schedule, find all of your dancer's dances and know every block of time you are required to attend.

- Please arrive fully dressed 30 minutes before your first time block. Early arrival is critical! It is not uncommon for DI to be 20 minutes ahead of schedule. We will not wait for your dancer if he/she is late. We must adhere to a strict schedule.
- Enter the auditorium dressed in your first costume (shoes included) and look for a picture of your costume taped to the end of a row of seats. Please have a seat in the row by your costume picture. Enter very quietly as a rehearsal on stage may be in progress.
- Parents must stay seated with their dancers in the auditorium. Every dancer must have a parent or guardian present for the duration of dress rehearsal.



DRESS REHEARSAL AT ALLEN PERFORMING ARTS CENTER Continued:

- A Dance Industry staff member will come to you and lead your dancers to the backstage area for their rehearsal. **Only dancers will go backstage.**
- After performing, a Dance Industry staff member will bring them back to the same seats. If you only have one dance, you are free to go after performing.
- For dancers with more than one dance, dressing rooms are open and will be available for costume changes. Parents are required to assist their dancers in the dressing room and return to the auditorium once dressed.
- After each performance and costume change, please return to the auditorium and look for your row with the picture of your costume and sit in the correct row.

BEFORE THE SHOW PREPARATION:

Create a checklist for all costume pieces for each dance and include what shoes. Making a list and checking it twice isn't just for Santa! Provide an individual hangup bag or XL Ziplock bag for each costume and include the correct genre of shoes in the bag. Please clearly label the bag in Sharpie with your dancer's name and the name of the dance. This will help out dressing room chaperones tremendously!

PRE-SHOW ARRIVAL/DROP OFF:

We will be using our color-coded system again this year for pick-up and drop-off. More details and video explanations will be provided closer to the event. Find out which color your class/classes are later in this packet.

All dancers are required to arrive 45 minutes before show time. Please ensure your dancer has everything at Dancer Drop-Off. Give them a quick hug and send good luck vibes! For safety reasons, no parents are allowed beyond this point. A Dance Industry Staff Member will escort your dancer to the appropriate dressing room.



Pre-Show Arrival/Drop Off CONTINUED:

Look for the colored tape lines at the end of the lobby foyer to form your line for drop-off. Volunteers and staff will be available to assist you if you have any questions. This process is designed to provide a smoother experience and ensure the safety of our dancers. We kindly ask that only ONE guardian drop off your dancer.

Once the house opens, please take your seat and enjoy the show! You will not be required to assist your dancer during the Revue. Sit back, relax, and get ready for "We Found Love!"

DANCER PICK-UP WILL BE BY COLOR IN THE LOBBY WHERE DROP-OFF WAS FOR EARLY RELEASE CLASSES.

MEDICAL NEEDS:

If your dancer needs an inhaler or any immediate medical needs with him/her backstage, please alert the front office immediately so we are aware and know proper care. Please make sure it is with your dancer when you leave him/her at Dancer Drop-off.

DRESSING ROOMS/BACKSTAGE:

Each dressing room will have numerous company dancer parents who volunteer as chaperones. Each chaperone has been provided with a clear format and was carefully chosen to provide the best care possible. Your dancers are in great hands! Dressing room chaperones will assist with keeping dancers safe and in the correct room, assisting every dancer with all costume changes, keeping voices soft, and the excitement building! There are bathrooms in each dressing room for convenience. A chaperone will be stationed in each dressing room to assist with this if needed.

When dancers are not dancing, we will have plenty of teen and adult crew members to play board games, color, read, and enjoy time with little dancers! Each dressing room will be stocked with toys, art supplies, and more to keep busy bodies busy! The backstage halls are filled with Dance Industry staff and crew members helping the flow of the show to and from the stage and monitoring dressing rooms from the outside. You are welcome to pack your dancer a water bottle and a healthy peanut-free/non-messy/non-meltable snack in a small bag. We will provide water and snacks in the dressing room for the dancers as well.

PICK-UP PROCEDURE:

Dancer pick-up will be in the lobby immediately following the show where drop off was by color. After the show, we kindly ask that all guests exit the theater immediately. The designated guardian picking up your dancer will find the color-coded lines in the lobby and line up according to your dancers color. DI staff and volunteers will guide the dancers by color into the lobby for pick up. While we aim to move as efficiently as possible, we appreciate your patience for everyone's safety. Please note that dancers will not be allowed to come find you. Don't worry—we will send reminders and provide video explanations to ensure a smooth pick-up process this year. This is the only pick-up location acceptable. Staff will stay with the dancers until all dancers have a parent arrive.

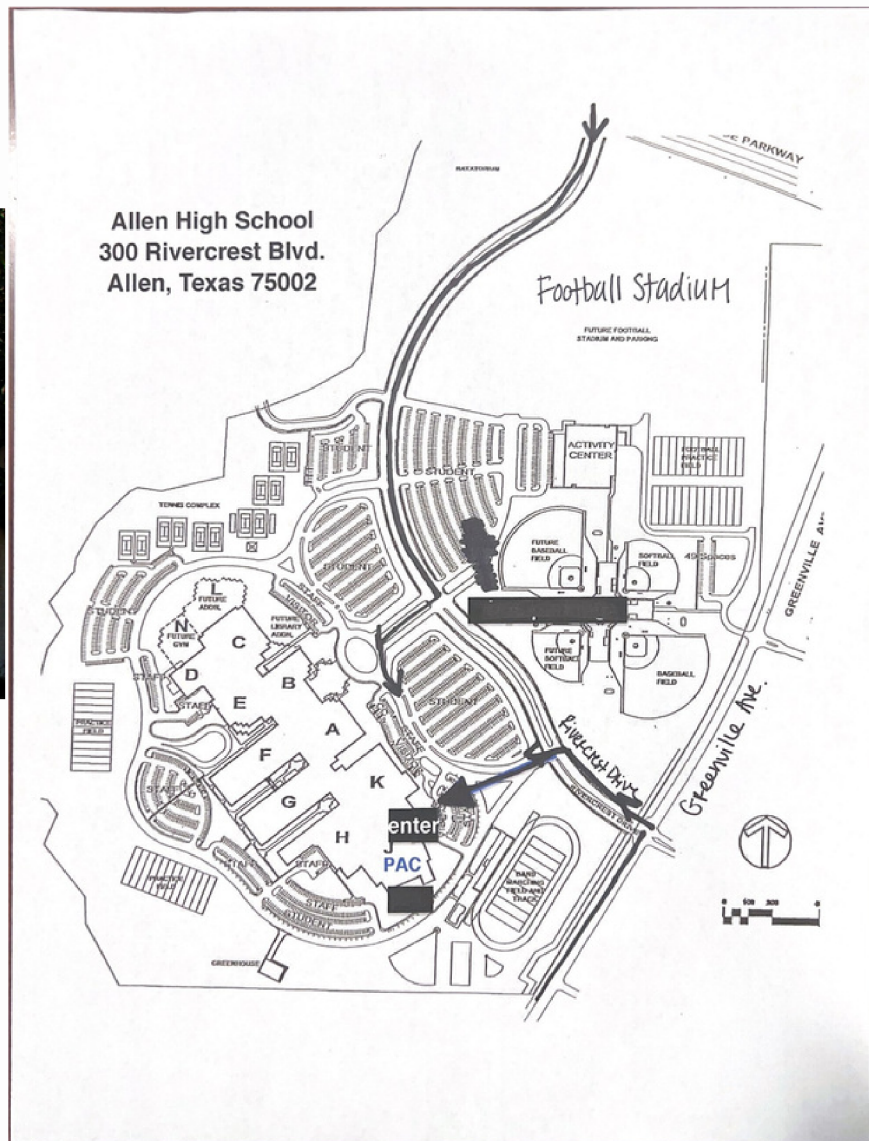
