Born and raised in Dallas, TX Lindsey began her dance training at the age of 3 years old. She is a University of Texas at Dallas graduate and holds a degree in Interdisciplinary Studies and Early Education. Currently Lindsey is on faculty educating young artists at several well known studios throughout Texas and the surrounding areas, including Dance Industry Performing Arts Center under the direction of Christy Wolverton. She Co-Founder with Gregory Dolbashian as the Managing Director and Lead Educator of The DASH Academy, a movement based training ground for developing young artists. DASH Academy launched their daytime training program combining online academics and dance education in August 2019 at Dance Industry Performing Arts Center. DASH Academy most recently debuted at Dancer's Give Back Dallas directed by Jess Hendricks. Throughout her adolescence, Lindsey received top-tier training from high calibre faculty including Jason Parsons, Justin Giles, Marty Kudelka, and Kim McSwain, and continuously received regional and national titles as a competitive dancer. She also was given the opportunity to begin assisting dance classes at the age of 14 and by the time she was a high school graduate she was co-directing competitive studio based companies within the southern region. She held the position of operational director and faculty member as part of a dance education agency where she traveled to studios across the country teaching, assisting, and consulting dance students and fellow educators in their craft.
