

We have just completed our annual aeration and overseeding of your lawn.

This process helps break up the thick layer of decayed grass clippings that develops over time ("thatch") and perforates the compacted soil, allowing more air, water, and nutrients to reach the turf's root system. It is a critical step in maintaining a full and healthy cool-season lawn.

Here are a few things <u>you</u> can do to help maximize the benefits of aeration:

- Water thoroughly on a daily basis until new grass is established at 5-6"
- Keep it clear of any leaves or debris (blow it off, etc.)
- Wait 3 to 4 weeks before mowing, and 1-2 months before allowing heavy traffic on the lawn
 - Always mow at a height of 4" or more

Germination under perfect conditions will not be for 10-14 days. It is critical for the seed to remain moist for this time period.

If it becomes too dry, that plant is lost!
