THIS MATTER came to be before the Court upon the joint request of the undersigned counsel for Plaintiff the State of Texas, and Defendants the City of Double Horn, Texas; Cathy Sereno; R.G. Carver; James E. Millard; Glenn Leisey; John Osborne; and Tom King (collectively, the "Parties"). As the result of mediation, the Parties have agreed to the attached Assurance of Voluntary Compliance, which sets forth the terms and conditions with which the City of Double Horn has agreed to comply in order to demonstrate to the State over the next year that it is operating as, and performing the functions required of, an incorporated city in the State of Texas. Pursuant to the Assurance of Voluntary Compliance, the Parties jointly agree, and respectfully request that the Court order, that further proceedings in this case be abated for a period of one year.

The Court being fully advised, it is HEREBY ORDERED that this matter will be abated for a period of one year to allow the City of Double Horn an opportunity to comply with the terms and conditions of the Assurance of Voluntary Compliance.


