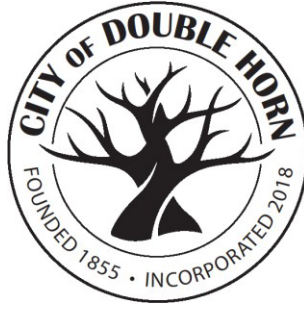




INTERESTED IN SERVING ON CITY COUNCIL AND YOUR COMMUNITY?

Are You Eligible?

To run for Mayor or City Council in the City of Double Horn, you must:

- Be a United States citizen.
- Have been a resident of Texas for at least **12 months** by the filing deadline.
- Have resided in the City of Double Horn for at least **6 months** preceding Election Day.
- Be a registered voter.
- Be at least **18 years old** by the beginning of the term of office.
- Not have been convicted of a felony unless pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities.
- Not have been declared mentally incompetent by a final court judgment.

How Do I File for a Place on the Ballot?

To become a candidate for Mayor or City Council, you must file an **Application for Place on the General Election Ballot** with the City Secretary.
