Home Safety Tips

| ☐ Leave outside porch lights, coach lights or flood lights on all night. |

| □ Install a wide - angle viewer on all exterior doors. |
| $\hfill \Box$ Check who is at the door and do not open the door to anyone you don't know. |
| ☐ Install good locks on all doors and windows. Use those locks! |
| $\hfill \square$ Be sure locks on doors and windows can be opened quickly in case of fire. |
| ☐ Leave a light on when you are not home. If you are on vacation, use a timer to control lighting. |
| □ Don't hide keys outside. |
| □ Remove house keys from your keychain when your car is serviced. |
| ☐ Talk with trusted neighbors. Keep an eye on their house and ask them to watch yours. |
| ☐ Have your lawn mown and snow shoveled when away. |
| □ Stop mail and newspaper delivery when you are away. |
| ☐ Install an alarm system that will detect entry and notify |
| police. |
| ☐ Close garage doors at night. |
| ☐ Keep trees and bushes trimmed. Do not let plants block doors and windows. |
