



How to sign up with **WarnCentralTexas.org**



The City of Double Horn is pleased to announce it is partnering with the Capital Area Council of Governments (CAPCOG) to offer an emergency notification system. CAPCOG uses a regional notification system, **WarnCentralTexas.org** to provide emergency communication in 10 central Texas counties. When local emergency personnel and government officials identify a serious threat, WarnCentralTexas.org will directly contact registered residents and businesses with vital information, such as:

- If or when to evacuate during floods and wildfires
- Severe weather alerts
- Areas to avoid if a nearby hazardous material spill occurs
- What residents should do during a police manhunt
- Health precautions during a boil water notice or prolonged power outage

By registering cell phones and email addresses to receive emergency alerts, residents can stay informed even when away from home. Contact information will be used only for emergency and major incident notification.

If you have not registered for emergency alerts with WarnCentralTexas.org, we encourage you to do so now. Go to WarnCentralTexas.org and click on the red “Get Alerts” button to create an account and indicate how you wish to receive notifications (text, email, phone).
