

**CITY OF DOUBLE HORN, TEXAS
ORDINANCE NO.2019-ORD012**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DOUBLE HORN, TEXAS ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE BURNET COUNTY TAX APPRAISAL DISTRICT CERTIFIED TAX ROLL; LEVYING TAXES IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORDINANCE NO. 2019-ORD-011; AUTHORIZING THE BURNET COUNTY TAX ACCESSOR AND COLLECTOR TO ASSESS AND COLLECT TAXES ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALING, SAVINGS AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Double Horn, Texas (the "City Council"), after holding a duly noticed public hearing, adopted Ordinance No. 2019-ORD-010 approving the 2019-2020 fiscal year budget of the City of Double Horn, Texas (the "City") on August 28, 2019; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Tax Code Section 26.052, the City Council on August 28, 2019 approved Ordinance No. 2019-ORD-011 setting an ad valorem tax rate of \$0.095000 for the maintenance and operations of the City and a debt service rate at \$0.000000 for a total rate of \$0.095000 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed value of taxable property; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Appraiser of the Burnet County Tax Appraisal District has prepared and certified the appraisal roll of the City, said roll being that portion of the approved appraisal roll of the Burnet County Tax Appraisal District which lists property taxable by the City, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with all applicable requirements of the Texas Tax Code prior to the setting of the tax rate for said City for 2019; and

WHEREAS, a quorum of the City council is present in a meeting open to the public; and

WHEREAS, all statutory and constitutional requirements concerning the levying and assessing of ad valorem taxes have been complied with.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOUBLE HORN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: Findings Incorporated. The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: Certified Tax Roll. The City Council hereby accepts and adopts the certified roll presented by the Burnet County Tax Appraisal District, and upon this certified tax roll, hereby levies and orders the assessment and collection of all real and personal property, not exempted from taxation by the constitution and laws of the State of Texas, located in the City of Double Horn beginning the 1st day of January 2019, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019, and

Ordinance Adopting Certified Tax Roll and Levying 2019 Property Tax
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ending September 30, 2020, for the use and support of the general operations of the municipal government of the City.

SECTION 3: Collection and Assessment of Ad Valorem Taxes. The Burnet County Tax Assessor and Collector is hereby authorized to assess and collect the taxes of said City employing the tax rate adopted by Ordinance No. 2019-ORD-011, the same being a total rate of \$0.095000 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) assessed value of taxable property. The assessments shall be due after the approval and publication of this Ordinance and Ordinance No. 2019-ORD-011, and not later than January 31st of the year following the year in which the taxes are assessed. Penalties and interest shall accrue after January 31st of the year following the year in which the taxes are assessed in accordance with Ordinance No. 2019-ORD-011.


SECTION 4: Appropriations in Accordance with Budget. That the Mayor, or City Secretary of said City, shall keep accurate and complete records of all monies collected under this Ordinance and Ordinance No. 2019-ORD-011, and the purposes for which same are expended. Appropriations shall be made in accordance with the FY 2019-2020 Budget approved by Ordinance No. 2019-ORD-010. All monies collected which are not specifically appropriated shall be deposited in the general fund of the City.

SECTION 5: Savings/Repealing Clause. All provisions of any ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed; but such repeal shall not abate any pending prosecution for violation of the repealed Ordinance, nor shall the repeal prevent prosecution from being commenced for any violation if occurring prior to the repeal of the Ordinance. Any remaining portions of conflicting ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: Severability. Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. City hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 7: Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.


