**Any person who violates or fails to observe any provision of The Peddlers Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Every day the violation continues and every occurrence or the doing of any act or thing prohibited, or the neglect or refusal to do any act or thing required by this Ordinance, shall constitute a separate offense. It shall not be necessary for the complaint to allege or for proof to be made that the act was knowingly done, nor shall it be necessary for the complaint to negate any exception contained in this article concerning any prohibited act, but any such exception made herein may be urged as defense by any person charged by such complaint.**
