

**CITY OF DOUBLE HORN, TEXAS
RESOLUTION NO. 2021-RES018**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOUBLE HORN, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE PROPERTY TAX INCREASE REFLECTED IN THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code §102.007(c) requires that adoption of a budget that raises more property tax revenue than was generated the previous year requires a record vote of the City Council to ratify the property tax increase reflected in the budget, in addition to and separate from the record votes to approve the ordinance adopting the annual budget and the resolution adopting the tax rate for the current tax year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Double Horn, Texas (the “City Council”) has approved an Ordinance adopting the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Budget, which will require raising more revenue from property taxes than last year’s budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to ratify the property tax increase reflected in aforementioned Ordinance approving the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOUBLE HORN, TEXAS, THAT:


SECTION 1. The property tax increase reflected in the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Budget and approved pursuant to aforementioned Ordinance adopting the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Budget is hereby ratified.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.




