

RESOLUTION NO. 2019- RES009

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOUBLE HORN, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF DOUBLE HORN ON NOVEMBER 5, 2019, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS THE PROPOSITION OF WHETHER THE CITY SHOULD ABOLISH ITS CORPORATE EXISTENCE; DECLARING THE RESULTS OF SAID ELECTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 62 of the Texas Local Government Code, a petition requesting a special election to determine whether or not the City of Double Horn, Texas (the “City”) should abolish its corporate existence was submitted to the Mayor on August 8, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Double Horn, Texas, (the “City Council”) ordered and called a Special Election to be held on November 5, 2019 for the purpose submitting to the resident, qualified electors of the City the following proposition (the “Proposition”):

SHALL THE CITY OF DOUBLE HORN, TEXAS (THE “CITY”), A TYPE-B GENERAL LAW MUNICIPALITY, ABOLISH ITS CORPORATE EXISTENCE AS PROVIDED BY TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, CHAPTER 62, AND SHALL THE MAYOR OF THE CITY BE AUTHORIZED TO DECLARE THE MUNICIPALITY ABOLISHED AND CERTIFY THE SAME TO THE BURNET COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT?; and

WHEREAS, the said Special Election of the City was held in the City on November 5, 2019, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M.; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has heretofore caused to be posted and published in accordance with the election laws of the State of Texas, notices of the Special Election; and

WHEREAS, notices of the Special Election were actually given by the City and the Burnet County Elections Administrator as required by state law; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary presented affidavits of posting and publication of the notices of the Special Election; and

WHEREAS, the affidavits of posting the publishing notices of the Special Election were examined and approved; and

WHEREAS, the Special Election was duly and legally held on November 5, 2019 in the City and in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of the Special Election, including the early voting results, have been certified and returned by the proper judges and clerks thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary, acting as special custodian of the election records, presented the canvass report for the Special Election, including the returns of the early ballots cast in connection therewith, to the Canvassing Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, acting in its capacity as the Canvassing Board for the Special Election, has considered the returns of said Special Election, including the returns of said ballots cast in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the returns of the Special Election, including the returns of early ballots cast in connection therewith, duly and legally made, showed that there were cast at said Special Election, the following total valid and legal votes:

WHEREAS, the City Council, at its Regular Council Meeting on November 14, 2019, canvassed the returns of said election.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOUBLE HORN, TEXAS:
