

Child Contributor Privacy Notice

For Children

If you are acting on behalf of a child (under the age of 18), please help them to read and understand this Privacy Notice.

Introduction

We have written this document (called a 'Privacy Notice') to explain how we use personal data about you when you (or your family member, chaperone, or guardian) take part in our content - one of our programmes (or a programme made by someone else which **ELECTRIC EYE FILMS LTD** will show), or other content, including podcasts, radio bulletins, articles, or content published on social media (we will refer to this as the 'Content' in this Privacy Notice).

You also might hear people calling you a 'Contributor' because of your involvement in the Content. This just means you have done something to help make the Content, whether in front of or behind the camera!

Remember, the content may be shown on TV and there might be some of your personal data in magazines, on our social media or YouTube channels, or online, which can be seen by lots of people. That is why it is important that you understand what types of personal data we collect and how it is used, and that we keep your personal data safe.

Who are we?

'**ELECTRIC EYE FILMS LTD**' is the company that will 'control' your personal data – this means that we decide how and why your personal data is used.

What personal data does **ELECTRIC EYE FILMS LTD** collect about me, and where does **ELECTRIC EYE FILMS LTD** get this from?

We need to collect some personal data about you. This includes:

Personal data that you or your parent/chaperone/guardian give to us-

Such as your name, date of birth, social media ID/handle, gender, nationality, where you live, information about you and your experiences, pictures and videos of you and how to contact you or your family member, friend, or guardian.

Some of the things we ask you may also be more personal, but we will make sure only people who need to know will see this. For example, we may ask about your health and if you have any allergies.

We may also ask information about your body and your feelings about it, the colour of your skin, your background, how you feel about people in charge of this country, or your religious beliefs.

Personal data from other people

We might see if you have a social media account or other information online.

We might also get your personal data from talent agencies or other companies involved in making Content.

How and why does ELECTRIC EYE FILMS LTD use my personal data?

We share your personal data:

- With people that work at ELECTRIC EYE FILMS LTD and with other companies we work with.
- To allow us to make, improve (including by using machine learning technologies), help us earn money from, and share the Content, or to supply benefits or services to you.
- With anyone who watches our Content.
- With your family member/chaperone/guardian or other representative.
- When we need to for legal reasons.
- Your personal data might be shared outside of this country. If that happens, we'll make sure to keep it safe.

How long does ELECTRIC EYE FILMS LTD need to keep my personal data for?

We have policies in place to make sure we keep your personal data only for as long as we need to keep it. This means that we will only hold on to it where it's necessary to do so.

What rights do I have?

You have choices about how we use your personal data. We might not always be able to fully help, but if this is the case, we will let you know why.

You can ask us to:

- Give you copies of the personal data that we collect about you.
- Correct or update any personal data we hold if you think it is wrong or incomplete.
- Get rid of your personal data or stop using it, if you don't want us to keep your personal data any longer.
- Give your personal data to you in a particular format, so that it is easy for you to pass it on to someone else.

- Stop using your personal data if you have agreed to us using it but have changed your mind.
