The Fee Application is granted, in its entirety; The fees and expenses incurred by the Receiver during the Monitorship 2. Period, in his capacity as the Court-appointed Monitor, in the respective amounts of \$75,000.00 and \$6,872.00, after application of the aggregate discount noted in the Fee Application, are approved; and 3. The Receiver is authorized to pay himself, immediately upon entry of this Order, 100% of his post-discount fees incurred during the Application Period, in the amount of \$75,000.00, and 100% of his post-discount expenses incurred during the Application Period, in the amount of \$6,872.00. Payment of the fees and expenses incurred during the Monitorship Period shall first be paid from the \$80,000.00 retainer held by the Receiver, as detailed in the Fee Application, and the remainder shall be paid from the assets of the Receivership Entities.
