PREPARING YOUR KITCHEN FOR THE RENOVATION

We are so excited to begin your kitchen cabinet refinish project! Your home is of great value and importance to us, so if you would assist in the preparation, it would be greatly appreciated. By following these guidelines, it will enable job efficiency, superior lasting results, and expedite the cabinet refinishing process.

HERE ARE SOME WAYS YOU CAN HELP

CABINETS: We ask that all items be removed from the inside, outside, and top of cabinets and countertops. Drawers will need to be emptied so we can remove them during the refinishing process. Please make sure the sink and dishwasher are clear of any dishes.

FLOORS: Please sweep your kitchen floors with a vacuum or wet/dry vac and then wet mop thoroughly. When dry, get a cloth and make sure to get any hair or dirt that may be up under the cabinets and along the toe kick area. We want to avoid any risk of contamination to the refinished product.

APPLIANCES: We are not responsible for moving appliances such as the refrigerator, dishwasher, or stove. If you want us to spray areas where these appliances normally sit, please have them moved out prior to start date. Failure to do this can cause a delay in the start of your project.

PETS: All animals need to be clear of the kitchen and surrounding area during the entire refinishing process. This will provide a safe work environment for our employees as well as your animals.

DURING THE RENOVATION: We ask that you refrain from using your kitchen area once the refinishing process has started. This will help keep any contaminants off the cabinets while we are working and will help us stay on schedule and avoid delays. While we are working in your kitchen it is considered a work zone and we ask that you stay out of the area to avoid injury and/ or damage to the cabinets. At certain points throughout the refinishing process, we may escort you through to let you see the progress.
