Change should be locally led, and we must amplify all voices in our community.

Contractor Overview

The Field Director is a seasonal contractor responsible for overseeing all aspects of field operations and Get Out The Vote (GOTV) efforts for four school board races. This position requires strategic planning, strong organizational skills, and the ability to lead and motivate a diverse team of staff and volunteers. The Field Director ensures effective voter engagement, manages canvassing logistics, and drives the overall success of the field campaign.

Responsibilities

The following are the main responsibilities for this contractor.

Field Operations Management:

- Develop and implement comprehensive field plans to maximize voter contact and engagement across the four school board races.
- Oversee day-to-day field operations, ensuring all activities are executed efficiently and effectively.
- Manage the logistics of canvassing efforts, including the development of plans, scheduling, and coordination of materials.

GOTV Efforts:

- Plan and execute robust Get Out The Vote (GOTV) strategies to ensure high voter turnout in each school board race.
- Coordinate with campaign leadership to align GOTV activities with campaign goals.
- Mobilize volunteers and staff to execute GOTV activities, such as phone banking, door-to-door canvassing, and ballot chase programs.

Staff and Volunteer Management:
