Respect For Authority

Understand that the founding committee will reserve the right to make any changes to costume, performance, or props that they deem necessary to the integrity of the event. By signing, you are stating that you will respect the final decision of those in authority. If you feel that there has been a misunderstanding, please let the committee know.

Respect for the C. S. Lewis company and the memory of Professor C. S. Lewis

Any and all acts, performances, and characters will be under the scrutiny and approval of the committee and the C. S. Lewis company. Anything that would not have had the approval of the Professor will not be allowed at the event. This is his work and in his memory we want to align to his wants and ideals for his creation as closely as we can.

Dress Code

Please remember that this is a G rated event. Any costumes that could be considered 'suggestive' will be required to make changes. This includes excessive cleavage, mid drift, or display of undergarments. (Please also remember that this event will be held in November, it'll be cold!) Any and all costumes are required to gain approval of the committee two weeks prior to the event.

Images
