Performance Rules

We cannot accept any performance applications if the performance contains any of the following:

- Tarot Reading
- Palm Reading
- Belly Dancing (with midriff showing)
- Performances with sexual innuendo/18+ themes
- Foul/ inappropriate language
- Graphic violence/ blood
