DIRECTIONS:



MATERIALS:

- 1 Piece of Black or Dark Blue) Construction Paper
- 1 Piece of Yellow Craft foam or Yellow Construction Paper
- 2 Pieces of Craft Foam (any color)*
- Old Plastic Tub Covers (from yogurt, sour cream, Tupperware, etc.)
- Craft Glue
- White Paint
- Glitter Glue (optional)
- Marker (any dark color)
- Animal Paw Print Template
- Star Template

*If craft foam isn't available, recycled Styrofoam can be used instead.

- 1. Cut out the star from the template.
- 2. Trace the star onto a piece of yellow craft foam or construction paper.
- 3. Glue the star onto the center of your black or blue paper.
- 4. Cut out a paw print from the template (or design your own for a real OR imaginary animal)
- 5. Trace the print onto craft foam (or Styrofoam).
- 6. Cut out the paw print.
- 7. Glue the paw print onto a recycled plastic tub cover (or an old sponge) and allow it to dry. You will use this to "print" your paw onto the page.
- 8. Use a paint brush or Q-tip to apply paint to the paw print. Now "print" the paw onto the page.

Note: You can skip this step and just paint a paw print onto your paper.

9. Once the paint dries, use markers and glitter glue to decorate your print. You can write the kind of animal whose print you chose and/or give your famous critter a Hollywood name like... STRONGHEART!
