



Bhaskara Rao, India: is a young neurosurgeon at the Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences and Technology in Trivandrum, Karela, India.. Together with his neurologist colleague Dr. K. Radhakrishnan, he has established the first and most active, modern epilepsy surgery programme in India. In the past five years this group has already performed 200 anteromesial temporal lobe resections, with results comparable to those obtained in industrialised countries. Dr. Rao and his colleague are the first to truly document the practicality of surgical intervention as a cost effective treatment for mesial temporal lobe epilepsy in the developing world.
