
Exhibit Coming June 1 to the Two Mississippi Museums— This is Home: Medgar Evers, Mississippi, and the Movement



This is Home: Medgar Evers, Mississippi, and the Movement exhibit will open on Thursday, June 1. This exhibit marks the 60th anniversary of the assassination of Medgar Evers by examining the life, death, and impact of the civil rights hero. As Mississippi field secretary for the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) from 1954 to 1963, Evers was involved in every major civil rights action during his career with the NAACP until his assassination in the driveway of his home on June 12, 1963. The exhibit will close on Friday, June 30. The Two Mississippi Museums' visitor hours are Tuesday–Saturday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sunday from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.
