Toward an African Methodist Episcopal Aesthetic

Idyll: Art and images at Wilberforce University **Tuesday,**

As the first independent African American religious denomination, the African Methodist Episcopal (AME) Church maintains a historic position as one of the oldest surviving African American institutions. Through the use and circulation of visual culture, the AME denomination established a cultural base of Black Formalist sensibilities rooted in uplift and cultural definition. This presentation will examine the role of art and visual representational strategies as an aesthetic idyll shaped by Bishop Daniel Payne and AME bishops of the nineteenth century. Denominational leadership marshalled images of Wilberforce University, the flagship educational institution of the denomination, as evidence of racial advancement through photographs exhibited at national expositions as well as news coverage published in the Christian Recorder.
