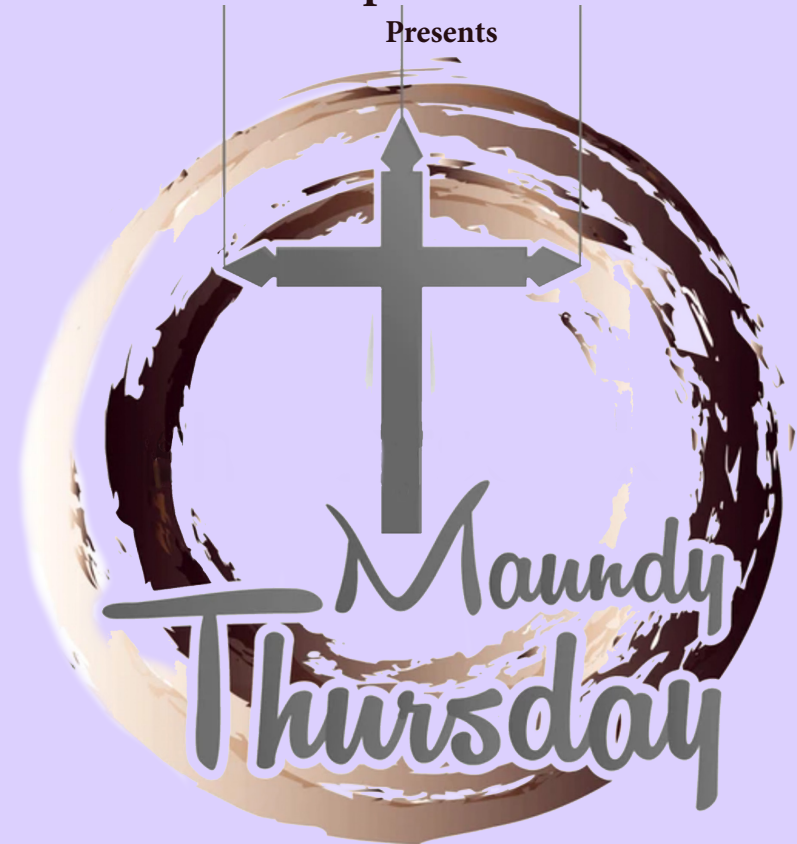

The Confession Prayer

Rev. Nicholas Tweed

L: Lord God sometimes it is hard for us to come to you because we have sinned against you in our thoughts, and words, and deeds, through negligence, through weakness, through our deliberate fault.

P: **We confess there are times when like Judas, we betray you.**

L: We remember how often we have fallen asleep and not been obedient to your call to watch and pray.

P: **Just as Peter denied and betrayed you so do we. We confess that we have denied you more times than three, and betrayed you.**

L: There are many times when we do not have the courage to stand and be counted in your name and we turn our backs on you and run.

P: **Perhaps we do not actually shout, "Crucify Him, but Lord by our words and our actions we have done just that.**

L: O God, we are very much like those first disciples. We acknowledge our sins of betrayal, denial and lack of courage, and ask that in your mercy you will hear our confession and forgive us.

P: **Lord have mercy on us.**

L: Christ have mercy on us.

ALL: Lord have mercy on us.
