This luscious and textural blend is very much a food wine; rich currant flavours provided by Grenache and tangy raspberry and spice from Cinsault before a dry and fresh finish.






Edalise Cotes du Provence Rosé - 2022 -\$14.95



Discover Edalise, Provence rosé masterpiece by winemaker Samantha Bailey.

This pale salmon-pink wine is a harmonious blend of florals, spice, and finesse, red berry fruit, white peach, and aromatics.

Samantha's expertise elevates this Côtes de Provence rosé to unmatched finesse and ethereal colour.



This harmonious blend brings together 3 classic grape varieties from Waterkloof's vineyards.

2 separate co-ferments, of Sauvignon/Chenin and Sauvignon/Semillon, are naturally fermented and aged 6 months in 600 ltr barrels then combined for a further 5 months maturation together.

The result is a wine of freshness, charm and substance.



Domaine de la Motte Petit Chablis - 2022 -

Chardonnay from vineyards at the top of the Michaut family's Chablis slopes where the terroir produces wines for earlier drinking but which still have classic Chablis charm.

The 2022 vintage has lovely ripe pineapple fruit, perfect balance and a fine mineral backbone.
