Carrie The Musical running March 3 – 11, 2023. When Carrie, a less-than-popular student with special powers, is mercilessly taunted by her peers, Sue takes pity on her and convinces her boyfriend to take Carrie to prom. But once there, the others play their most mortifying prank yet and Carrie takes deadly revenge on them all.

Peter and the Starcatcher explores how a young orphan ultimately becomes the legendary Peter Pan. From marauding pirates and jungle tyrants to unwilling comrades and unlikely heroes, Peter and the Starcatcher playfully explores the depths of greed and despair ... and the bonds of friendship, duty and love. This performance will take place in May 2023.

Along with the Main Stage performances, JHS will host the Discovery Series again this year. Introduced in 2021, this series is home to smaller, more intimate productions developed in the classroom studio and is dedicated to the process of the students developing their craft. The Discovery Series performances include:

A Night of Love & Broadway directed by Cami Glauser allows students to showcase their talent and bring our community an experience that captures the heart with Broadway's most powerful love songs intertwined with excerpts from romantic plays. This show will run October 21 - 22, 2022.

The Drowsy Chaperone directed by Kyle Broady. When a die-hard theatre fan plays his favorite cast album, the characters come to life in this hilarious musical farce. Show dates are November 11 – 13, 2022.
