Rules for Schooling Hunter/Jumper Series 2020

1. You must sign up and pay for rounds in advance. **ALL ENTRIES ARE DUE JUNE 19TH.**
2. The day of the show, you will check in and be given tickets for the rounds you purchased. Tickets must be presented at the entry gate before your round.
3. Release of Liability waivers must be signed by each rider upon arrival onto the property.
4. We will assign ride times and post on Facebook and the website Thursday, June 25th.
5. There will be several course options for each level. You can do whichever course(s) you choose, including a gambler's choice where you make up your own course.
6. No refunds for unused tickets.
7. There will be 2 arenas for warm-ups. Please try to minimize the number of riders in the arena at one time.
8. In order to help ensure social distancing, you must be ready at your specified ride time. If you are not ready to ride, you will forfeit your time/ticket.
9. If a rider falls and is not injured, they may get back on and finish the round.
10. Coaches/Trainers may coach from inside the arena.
11. Once you finish your rounds, please exit the property as soon as possible in order to help maintain social distancing.
12. Please no dogs.

Safety is our number one concern! Please maintain social distancing as much as possible. We want everyone to come and experience a show with quality fences in a no stress atmosphere. We ask everyone cooperate to keep the show moving quickly and smoothly.
