
## Freeform / Kidney Measurement Instructions

If original manufacturer's pool drawings are not available, an A-B plot of the pool perimeter must be given. Liner A-B points must be measured as follows:

- In your drawing, the deep end of the pool must be on the left side with your A and B points shown underneath the pool.
  - Make A-B line at least 12' wide. It cannot cross the pool, if extended.
- Specify A & B Points at hopper transitions. You must have the pool drawn from directions shown with (A) on the left and (B) on the right.



- Keep measurements to 1/2" increments. They do not have to be evenly spaced around the pool. (Every 11/2 feet around the large radius—sharp turns or inside turns every 6 inches.)
- 4) If the pool has cut out type step, include points at the front of the step where pool panel would be if there were not a step.
- 5) With A-B plot, please give a detailed drawing of the pool. Show all interior dimensions and detail the hopper contour.
  - (Include whether the slope of the hopper follows the curve or is straight.) Fill out standard custom liner order form with pattern, dimensions A, B, C & D.
- Measure the pool perimeter around the bead track. List the total perimeter distance.
