***Perpetuating Western Mono culture and relationships
with Cradleboards***

My name is Chrissy Atwell Valle, my tribal membership is from Big Sandy Rancheria of the western band of Mono Indians, I am also of Tachi and Chukchansi descent. My oldest grandbaby is seven years old so I've been weaving for that long. It is customary in our tribe/culture for a woman to begin weaving the basket for her grandchild. I now have five grandbabies and have made 41 baskets; 30 newborn cradles, seven double back cradles, three doll baskets, and one large gathering basket. I am currently weaving my youngest grandbabies double back and it fills my heart to do so.
