Yokut Basketry Practices & Teachings

Carmen Moreno is a lineal descendant of the Tachi and Wukchumni Yokut tribes, and Hispanic people of the Central Valley. She participated in the AICLS Master-Apprentice program as an apprentice with her mother, the late Lawona 'Oswick' Icho Jasso, who was a Community Tachi Language Teacher, Culture Practitioner, and basket weaver. With her family, she has continued traditional practices in many ways from learning the language, practicing cultural traditions, stories, songs, prayers. To gathering food items, basket materials and most of all; practicing respect for the land and others. Today, Carmen and her family have and will continue her mother's work and legacy that has been given to them to share with others.
