Reminders: Sewer

Please remember that NOTHING other than toilet paper can be released into our sewer system (By flushing or by any other means). Feminine napkins of any kind, along with wipes (including disposable ones) are continually damaging pumps and pump controllers involving costly repairs.

Building and Grounds

Any leaves can be bagged up, tied, and left on the street for pick-up. (no other items mixed in)

Trimmed tree or bush branches (3 feet long max) may be left at the road for pickup.

No dumping of any kind by owners in the leaves dump.

If full trees or bushes are cut down, all debris must be removed from the park by the owner or owner's contractor.

Do not leave any construction, yard debris, or furniture in or around the dumpsters. No wheeled vehicles including golf carts, bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, etc., are allowed on the basketball/pickleball court.


Architectural Guidelines Reminder
