PURPOSE The Men of Beechtree Scholarship Fund was established in 2016. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to students, that are residents of the Beechtree community and plan to continue their education at a two- or four-year college or university.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on academic performance, leadership, and potential.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Men of Beechtree awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Personal Essay, and individual interviews. **The Men of Beechtree** pays scholarship funds directly to the educational institution fall semester of each year. Men of Beechtree Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

• Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.8 on a 4.0 scale.

• Applicants must be accepted as a full-time (12 or more credit hours) student at a college or university for the upcoming academic semester.

- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Applicants must be a primary resident of Beechtree.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by May 30th.

TIMELINE

- Applications are due May 30th.
- Candidates will be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee.
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by August 1st.

Application Process

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official proof of academic standing.
- A current letter of academic references from a guidance counselor or teacher.
- A current letter of reference from an employer or community member.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic school for post-secondary studies.
- A one-page essay on "Why you want/deserve this scholarship."

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- Awards will be given by September 15.
- Applicant must provide their student ID# (if known), the correct mailing address of their institution and the department where the scholarship check is to be mailed.
- Award amounts will be distributed directly to the college or university.
