SPECIFICATIONS:

1. WALLS & PARTITIONS:

- A. FRAMERS shall eliminate unnecessary third studs In every corner possible. (Exterior walls shall be free of un-insulated corner boxes.)
- B. FRAMERS shall install Cymax Stud-Ćlaw™
 GC-1.5 Corner Backer Springs (About 16" O.C.)
 wherever drywall panel backing is required.

2. JOIST FRAME CEILINGS:

- A. FRAMERS shall install Cymax Stud-Claw™ GC-3.0 Ceiling Backer Springs (About 16" O.C.) wherever drywall ceiling backers are required.
- B. DRYWALLERS shall nail or screw all exterior drywall panels to the ceiling and floor plates of the structural outside walls.
- C. DRYWALLERS shall FLOAT all interior partition corners. (Omit ceiling fasteners within 8" of interior partition corners and omit wall fasteners within 8" of interior ceiling corners. Springs are installed before vapor barrier film)

3. TRUSS FRAME CEILINGS:

- **A. FRAMERS** shall secure trusses to exterior walls with appropriate framing brackets.
- B. FRAMERS shall NOT toe-nail lower truss chords to interior partition plates. (Toe-nailed trusses can lift partition walls off the floor with truss movement.
- C. FRAMERS shall plumb interior partitions and secure to truss chords with Cymax TB-1 Truss Float-R™ Brackets.
- D. DRYWALLERS shall nail or screw all exterior drywall panels to both ceiling and floor plates of the structural outside walls.
- E. FRAMERS or DRYWALLERS shall install Stud-Claw™ Ceiling Backers (About 16" O.C.) wherever drywall ceiling backing is required. (Springs must be installed before vapor barrier film)
- F. FRAMERS shall install bridging between lower chords (when trusses run parallel to partitions) to accommodate Truss Float-R™ Brackets.
- G. DRYWALLERS shall FLOAT all interior partition corners. (Omit ceiling truss chord fasteners within 12"-16" of interior walls and omit wall fasteners within 8" of interior ceiling corners)




