

Fiesta Travel Designs–“Rules for the Road”

In order to make our bus trips as pleasant as possible for everyone onboard, following is a **list of rules** which were decided based on past trips and feedback received.

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1. If you listen to your telephone, ipad, or dvd player, you must use **earbuds** so as to not disturb others.
2. When you board the bus on the day of initial departure, choose **your seat** wisely, as this is the place you must return to each time we stop and get “on and off” the bus. Do not move someone else’s belongings and take their seat. If you are unhappy with your seat, you are welcome to move to a seat that is empty, if there are any.
3. If there is **trash** you wish to discard, place it in a hanging bag near you, or hold onto it until our next stop and put into the trash bag in front of bus or a trash can at service station or restaurant. Don’t put cups with liquid or ice into onboard trash bag, as this causes spills which can cause someone to fall. Wait and empty this when you get off bus. This will cut down on amount of trash in hanging bags – as this can restrict the bus walking path.
4. Cups/tumblers brought onto bus must have “**screw on**” lids so as to prevent **spills** (and falls). Sodas or cold coffee bottles with screw on tops are acceptable. If you purchase fountain drinks, **transfer them** to cups/tumblers with screw on, or snap on, lids that are secure.
5. When bus stops at a location where we will **disembark**, stay seated until bus comes to a full stop, then wait for driver to get off bus first – as he/she must stand at foot of steps until all passengers are safely off. Same applies to re-boarding. If the driver is not at bus, wait for one of our team to open bus and assist passengers with boarding.
6. When disembarking, we will always try to let the front and back of bus **take turns** going first. If it is your turn, you must be ready to get off the bus as soon as possible. Please don’t linger in the aisle.
7. If you put some of your belongings into **overhead bin**, make sure there are no items which will **fall out** (loose) when the bin is opened later.
