Tasting Note:

Montagny is made up of four distinct chunks of land. The northern-most, by the village of Buxy, with south facing, sheltered soils is where this wine comes from. It's quite different from Mâcon as it retains a mineral and lime nose nicely rounded off with a splash of cream



Technical Detail:

GRAPE VARIETY: 100% CHARDONNAY

AGED in French Oak Barrel

LOCATION

VINES: 30-year-old

ABV: 13%

SOIL Clay & Limestone, east , south-east slopes

Hand picked

Wild Yeast

CLOSURE: Cork

Food Pairing:

Excellent with Sushi, Sashimi, fresh seafood.

Textured fish like sea bream.

Good with poultry, fried or roasted chicken and turkey
